

Nursery Protocols for Sylvania UCC

adopted by the COVID Committee; revised on 10/8/2021

The Nursery is currently closed. When the nursery reopens, the following procedures will be followed.

- In accordance with our church's Safe Church Policy, staff members as well as volunteers working in the nursery have indicated that they have received the COVID-19 vaccination.
- We will maintain a ratio of 2 children to 1 adult; at minimum we will have 2 nursery workers present each Sunday which will allow for 4 children.
- Masks are required for all children ages 3+ as well as nursery workers.
- Children are to be dropped off and picked up at the nursery door.
- Each child's hands will be washed at arrival and at departure. Nursery workers will wash their hands upon arrival, at departure, and during nursery hours as appropriate.
- A bin will be set aside for anything that has gone into a child's mouth so that it doesn't remain in rotation.
- Snacking will be allowed.
- Windows will be opened whenever possible.
- High-touch surfaces will be wiped down prior to nursery opening and after closing. High touch surfaces include light switches, tables, chairs, doorknobs, bathroom fixtures, and diaper changing station.
- Each child's personal belongings will be kept separate as much as possible.
